Meeting Called to Order:

Chairman Hurwitz called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioners Present:

Chairman Ben Hurwitz, Commissioner Rod Brewer and Vice-Chairman Errol Galt were present for the meeting.

ACTION #1

Commissioner Galt moved to approve the minutes from October 14th, 2025. Commissioner Brewer seconded. A vote was taken and passed.

Public Comment:

Cemetery Sexton Randy Harden entered the chambers at 8:27 a.m.

Harden discussed with Commissioners the need for a speed limit sign at the Cemetery to deter people driving excessive speeds. Harden also brought in the official bid for a building at the Cemetery for the total amount of \$98,150.00.

Library Report-Rachel Wahlstrom

Library Co-director Rachel Wahlstrom entered the chambers at 8:58 a.m.

Wahlstrom reported that the library has recently started up their weekly Story Time program for children, held every Wednesday from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The program has seen strong participation, with approximately 30 children attending, many of whom are from Wilsall, Montana. In addition, the library has initiated regular book reading sessions for the two local preschools. Wahlstrom also noted the establishment of a new technology assistance program for seniors, now available at the senior center.

Wahlstrom informed the Commissioners the library was invited to conduct a survey on behalf of the Montana State Library. The initiative primarily involves completing a questionnaire that gathers statistical data from the library. The objective is to assess and measure the growth and impact of the library's programming initiatives.

Wahlstrom and Co-Director Washburn recently completed the Director Conference held in Great Falls and Wahlstrom along with Zimmerman attended the Fall Conference at Chico Hot Springs.

Wahlstrom has initiated the groundwork for a county mill levy this spring and will soon present the proposal to the Commissioners for their signatures.
